# Scheduled construction activities

#### **Central SANGs**

- Tree removal is taking place to align with the wildfire management plan that has been agreed upon with the local authorities. This work has begun and will continue until the end of the year.
- Dead wooding within the central SANGS is ongoing and will complete before Christmas. This work has been undertaken to improve the safety for those using the footpaths.
- Areas within the central SANGS are fenced off due to historic debris within the soil which requires remedial works. Regular ground and air monitoring is in place to ensure there is no danger to the public.

**Southern Drainage Basins** 

 Construction of the southern drainage basins will begin in February 2020 and will take 18 weeks to complete. The basins are a critical part of the Development's sustainable urban drainage system (SuDs).

#### **Ecology update**

As the weather gets colder, it moves into hibernation season. Reptiles will hibernate when they can no longer keep warm enough to have energy to be active and hunt. Reptiles will hibernate from October until around March/April, but this is dependent on the seasonal temperatures. They can be found hibernating in a range of locations, such as under tree roots and rocks, or some reptiles will burrow into the ground. Across Deepcut we have adders, slow worms, common lizards and grass snakes.
