Winter Ecology Most of the local bat species will be hibernating over the winter period, to reappear around April, including species such as Pipistrelle and Brown Long-Eared bats.

Badgers do not hibernate, however they can go into periods of extended sleep for a few days during particularly harsh winters. Cubs are born between late January and early March, with peak births in February. There are badger setts and general activity across the whole Mindenhurst site, with setts located along Deepcut Bridge Road, the Basingstoke Canal, and the Central SANGS.

Red Deer and Roe Deer are popular in this area. They are usually solitary, but form small groups over winter to feed and are most active at dawn and dusk.

Hedgehogs hibernate to bypass the cold months when food becomes scarce. If the weather isn't too cold and food is put out for them every night, some might not feel the need to hibernate. Cat or kitten biscuits can be left out to help the hedgehogs during the winter.
