Construction Update

- 1 After Easter we will begin upgrading a number of DIO roads, including Newfoundland, Canada, Union, and Cyprus Roads. We will stagger the works to reduce disruption and will inform affected residents. For the latest information please check our website or get in touch at hello@mindenhurst.co.uk.
 - 2 Our construction team is progressing with the new Loop Road construction.
 - 3 Ongoing infrastructure improvement works at Brunswick Road, located inside the camp gates, may result in increased traffic due to material and equipment deliveries.
 - 4 We are making good progress at the church, with final touches on the external refurbishment, such as painting, glazing and timber repairs, underway.
 - 5 Our teams continue to maintain the landscaping throughout the site, focusing on the Village Green and Central SANGs areas.
-  We will soon begin landscaping work in the Central SANGs area, where the team will move inside the fence line as they look to complete the landscaping works in this area.



Blu-3 Electrical Works

Blu-3 has now finished the works on Deepcut Bridge Road and the team is progressing along Lake Road towards Frimley Green. The works on Lake Road will take approximately nine weeks to complete.

Due to the close proximity to the school, Blu-3 has paused work on Hamesmoor Road and will be returning to complete the works during the Easter school holiday. They are currently working on Coleford Bridge Road towards the Coleford Interchange where they will cross into Hampshire.

Footpath Closure in the Central SANG

We have temporarily closed a stretch of footpath in the Central SANG whilst work is carried out on the bank between the Bovis Homes development and the SANG.

Work began on **7 March** and is expected to take three months.
